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Scope of Work:

To provide Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner to the residents of Girl's hostels of the institute in a hygienic way. The number of students may vary due to diet-based system. The scope of work covered by the contract is broadly but not extensively described as given below: -

- (i) Cooking and serving meals (breakfast, lunch and dinner) to student residing in the institute's Girls Hostel.
- (ii) To serve regular meals within institute premises as and when required beyond mess service. Caterer needs to provide breakfast, lunch and dinner to institute guests as and when required.
- (iii) Cleaning of utensils, kitchen and serving items before and after each meal.
- (iv) Cleaning of cooking, dining, washing and auxiliary areas including furniture and other equipment in the mess premises after each meal.
- (v) Security and maintenance of the equipment, utensils and other items in the mess.
- (vi) Maintenance of books, ledgers, suggestion book, other records and documents related to running the mess and as asked for by the Mess Committee/Hostel Authorities.
- (vii) Deployment and supervision of required manpower for the above- mentioned tasks.
- (viii) Recovery of mess dues from students based on taking actual meals in the mess.
- (ix) Procurement of raw material as per specification decided by Mess Committee/Hostel Authorities.
- (x) Check list as prescribed by FSSAI for routine inspection (Catering/Food/Service & Establishment)
- (xi) All material brought by the contractor to the work site shall have to be declared at the security gate and no material shall be allowed to be taken out from the premises without proper approval.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. The bidder should have a permanent place of business in Ambala District and the complete Postal Address, Telephone/ Mobile/E-mail address, etc. should be provided, while submitting the completed tender form.
2. Applicant must have minimum 3 years' experience of running such hostel mess in Govt. or other educational institutes having not less than 100 persons on its dining strength (not earlier than Six years) and must enclose latest certificate in this regard. The contractor/firm should have valid PAN and he should be FSSAI registered. Moreover contractor/firm shall ensure that its employees are covered under ESI/EPF/ Labour act etc.
3. The tender must be accompanied by Earnest Money (EMD) of Rs. 70,000/- (Seventy thousand Only) in the form of DD from any Nationalized Bank drawn in favor of Principal, Kalpana Chawla Govt. Polytechnic for Women, Ambala City, Ambala.
4. The amount of earnest money shall not be accepted through cheque or cash. The DD of EMD shall be placed in sealed envelope of Part A: Technical Bid. The earnest money of the tenders(s) will be refunded without interest within Two (02) weeks after the award of the mess contract.
5. Conditional/telegraphic/incomplete tender received through fax, e-mail or tenders without earnest money and submitted not on the prescribed form shall not be entertained.
6. The tenderer should submit copies of all documents duly signed in three sealed envelopes as per requirement of this document as under: -
 - i) First sealed envelope should be super-scribed as "Part A: Technical Bid".
 - ii) Second sealed envelope should be super-scribed as "Part B: Financial Bid".
 - iii) Third (Main/Outer) sealed envelope wherein the First and Second sealed envelopes containing "Technical Bid" and "Financial Bid" should be inserted, must be super scribed as "TENDER FOR GIRLS HOSTEL MESS AND INSTITUTE CANTEEN IN KALPANA CHAWLA GOVT. POLYTECHNIC FOR WOMEN, AMBALA CITY."
7. The tender shall be evaluated on the basis of rates quoted per day. In case lowest bidder is not found suitable or disqualified, the tender can be awarded to the next higher bidder. The decision of the competent authority in all the matters shall be final.
8. Genuineness of rates quoted will be decided by the Mess Committee/Competent Authority. The committee as constituted will have full power to discard any offer where rates quoted are not genuine. The decision of the committee in this regard will be full and final and binding on all bidders. If required the evaluation committee can act as negotiation committee for the purpose of award of contract.
9. The Contractor will have to deposit Rs. 50000/- per annum on account of maintenance charges of various facilities excluding electricity charges provided in the hostel mess with the cashier of the institution. The canteen maintenance charges of Rs. Twenty-four thousand (Rs. 24,000) per year are to be paid in two instalments in advance by the contractor i.e Rs. 12,000/- each at the starting of both the semesters.
10. The Contractor shall be responsible for depositing of electricity charges with the cashier of this institute as per the electricity bill failing which penalty @ Rs. 100/- per day will be charged. The contractor will install sub-energy meter himself and will pay the electricity charges as per

institute rules.

11. The contractor should comply with the Minimum Wages Act, Workmen's Compensation Act and Child Labour Act. The Institute shall not be liable in case any dispute takes place between the caterer and his employees.
12. The Contractor must have valid EPF Code No. /ESI Code No./Service Tax Code No., if applicable, throughout the period of contract. He will be responsible to deposit EPF, ESI, Service Tax, etc. with the respective departments in respect of the persons employed by him. The Institute will not be responsible for any liability on this account, whatsoever. The Contractor shall ensure regular health checkup of his employees.
13. The bidder shall be at liberty to be present in person or through their authorized representative with authority letter from the bidder at the time of opening of technical and financial bid. If any bidder or his representative is not present the committee reserves the right to open the tender.
14. 'Terms and Conditions' as well as copies of all documents related to Technical/Financial bids should be duly signed and stamped by the bidder. Corrections/overwriting is not allowed.
15. The Service Tax, if applicable, should be indicated clearly in the tender form as "Service Tax Extra" along with the percentage of Service Tax as applicable failing which it will be treated that the rates quoted by the tenderer are inclusive of service tax. After this no representation/request regarding payment of service tax shall be entertained. Service Tax will be paid to the tenderer provided the service tax registration number, Service Tax Code and Accounting Code is mentioned on the bill/invoice and all relevant formalities including furnishing of forms, if any, are fulfilled by the tenderer.
16. The bidder should enclose the copies of filled ITR of last 03 years (Latest).
17. If two or more than two firms quote the same rate then the final decision will be taken by the committee on the basis of merit of following points: -
 - (i) Work Experience in Educational institute
 - (ii) Work experience in Women institute
 - (iii) Turnover.
18. The successful bidder to whom the contract has been offered, if he/she does not respond in stipulated period, the offer shall stand cancelled. Earnest money deposited by such contractor/bidder shall be forfeited and the work will be awarded to the second highest bidder.
19. Merely quoting of lowest rates does not automatically entitle any firm to get the work awarded in its favor. Any contractor submitting a bid which is considered unrealistically low shall be out-rightly rejected. Feasibility of quality of food will be given priority.
20. Rate from the successful bidder will be mutually negotiable.
21. The successful bidder to whom the contract has been offered shall be required to deposit an amount of Rs. 70000/- (Seventy thousand Only) as performance security valid for 01 year duly pledged in favor of Principal, Kalpana Chawla Govt. Polytechnic for Women, Ambala City payable at Ambala, in the form of Demand draft (DD) issued by any nationalized bank within 03 working days after the completion of tender process/award of work, which will be refunded on expiry of the contract after getting, NOC from Principal, Kalpana Chawla Govt. Polytechnic for

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- Women, Ambala City 134003 payable at Ambala. The suitable deductions will be made out of the security amount, if any goods/ equipment's are found to be damaged by contractor.
22. The successful bidder shall furnish the required performance security and execute an agreement on a non-judicial stamp paper of Rs.100/- to be purchased by him (embodying the Terms & Conditions of the Tender) within 15 days from the date of acceptance of the agreement.
 23. In the event of opening date of technical/financial bid being declared as holiday the tender will be opened on the next working day at the same time and place.
 24. The Principal reserves the rights to accept or reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reason whatsoever at any time/stage. The Principal reserves the right to modify, impose or relax any clause in the terms and conditions.
 25. The decision of short listing of technical bid by Principal will be final and binding on all. The Financial Bid of only those technically short-listed tenderers based upon the assessment made of credentials etc. will be opened.
 26. Bidders are advised to inspect/visit the available premises/resources before quoting the rates on any working day.
 27. The contract will be awarded for a period of one year i.e. 1st Aug. 2026 to 31st July, 2027 at the first instance. The contract may be extended for one more year and maximum up to 03 (Three) years based on good and satisfactory performance certified by Mess Committee/ competent authority with enhancement up to 10% per annum of relevant dues (maintenance charges, mess charges.), on mutual consent of both parties and based on the requirement of this office.
 28. Although, initially the contract will be awarded for a period of one year. However, in case of unsatisfactory service or misbehavior by the contractor or his employees it may be terminated at any time by the Principal after giving one-month notice.
 29. The list of residents, who will compulsorily join the mess, shall be provided by the hostel authorities from time to time. The number of residents may vary depending upon academic session and vacations. However, a significant variation is not envisaged on day to day basis.
 30. The contractor shall not be entitled to allow any other person to occupy the mess/canteen or to use any part thereof. The contractor shall not admit any person into partnership or become partner or to let or sub-let the mess. The caterer / his servant(s)/ his nominee will not be permitted to stay overnight in the hostel premises. The premises of the mess will be used for the purpose for which the allotment will be made and not for any other purpose without the written permission of the competent authority.
 31. The contractor shall provide adequate number of mess servants (not below the age of 18 years. All should be clean, neatly dressed, medically & physically fit as well as civil, sober and honest in their dealings with the students, staff and others. The contractor will be responsible for the conduct and behavior of the servants under his employment. However, the contractor should provide the necessary detail of all its employees (permanent, temporary, casual) to the institute. All the employees should be police verified. No person with any offensive police record shall be employed to work in the Hostel/Institute Mess. Medical fitness certificate of the entire

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employees has to be submitted to this institute. The Contractor will engage his labour to execute the work, satisfactory as allotted. Such persons engaged by the Contractor shall be his employees for all intents and purpose.

32. The contractor shall provide the services in professional and efficient manner. The contractor shall display the menu at appropriate place in the mess/canteen. If any item is not served as per the menu, a suitable penalty will be imposed by the competent authority. He himself shall be responsible for the recovery of mess dues from students based on monthly mess bill. The last day for payment would be 10th day of every month.
33. Special light food (like: Khichadi, dalia and hot water) should be served for sick students on request in advance.
34. The sanitation of mess/canteen kitchen, mess service area and toilets shall be the sole responsibility of the contractor at his own cost including pest control. All the items stored or served shall be properly kept to prevent contamination by flies and dust.
35. The Caterer shall use only branded raw material and best quality products for preparing the mess food and canteen items. All items should bear FSSAI stamp and should comply to the Food Safety Act, 2006.
36. The Institute Hostel/Mess Committee will ensure maintenance of proper hygienic conditions and quality of the food served by the contractor. In case the contractor fails to maintain proper hygiene and quality in food, then a suitable penalty may be imposed as deemed necessary by the competent authority. For providing inferior quality of services continuously, Institute reserves the right to cancel the contract. In this eventuality, the security deposit will be forfeited and the tenderer is liable to be blacklisted upto five years. If Tender gets cancelled, then vendor has to continue mess service till arrangement of new contractor.
37. Contractor will cook the food by engaging female workers preferably.
38. Mess contractor will have to provide meals as per menu (Annexure-I) and (Annexure – II) for canteen. The mess menu can be changed on mutual understanding of mess committee and contractor with due permission of competent authority. Non-Veg. food is strictly prohibited in the Institute hostel.
39. The caterer/contractor shall display proper mess bill for each month for which payment will be made by students and receipt of payment will be provided to the students. A copy of bill will be sent to Warden Office for information.
40. The mess contractor shall maintain the record of inspections and suggestions separately. The same should be brought to the notice of Institute Hostel/ Mess Committee at the end of every month.
41. The Institute would be providing only requisite furniture on free of cost basis for running mess only. Furniture for canteen (Tables, Chairs etc.) will be provided by the contractor.
42. Kitchen equipment, Chulha, fridge etc. will be installed by the contractor at his own cost. No Electrical appliances such as electrical heater shall be allowed to be used in the hostel mess. All service utensils like plates, glasses, dongas, service spoons etc. will be arranged by the contractor. Upkeep and maintenance of furniture provided in the dining hall and canteen by the Institute will be the sole responsibility of the contractor.
43. The contractor will make his own arrangement for utensils, cooking gas, crockery, cutlery,

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glasses and another kitchen equipment. Disposable good quality paper made items for tea etc. shall be allowed, however contractor cannot use any plastic material. Beside this, all utensils like plates, spoons, glasses etc. to be used for serving students will be provided by the contractor.

44. The contractor shall bear all the expenses for running the mess. The institute shall not be liable for any damage caused due to incidents like theft, burn, natural calamity, fire, electric shock etc. The contractor shall bear any compensation for damage on injury or injury caused to its workmen while discharging their duty.
45. Three (03) or more complaints of unclean utensils/crockery in a day may lead to fine of Rs. 500/- on the caterer. Clean & presentable crockery to be used.
46. Sale or use of Tobacco products, Alcoholic products and other intoxicants are strictly prohibited. Playing cards and smoking is prohibited in the hostel/institute premises. The contractor and his employees shall have to observe all the by-laws/rules of Haryana Govt. and Institute authorities fixed from time to time.
47. If at any stage the involvement of the caterer in any uncalled-for activity is found, inside or outside the premises of the Institute, which may bring disrepute to the Institute, the contract is liable to be terminated by the competent authority without giving any prior notice to the caterer.
48. All items will be cooked in the kitchen of the hostel.
49. The Institute may ask the caterer to serve regular meals within its premises as and when required beyond mess service. Caterer needs to provide breakfast, lunch and dinner to Institute guests as and when required.
50. The caterer would provide breakfast, lunch and dinner. Each of these will have certain items mandatory for the caterer to provide as a part of the basic menu. Besides these, certain other items (add-ons) will be available on extra messing. The mess menu along with mandatory items is listed in the detail in Annexure-I. The hostel committee reserves the right to change the menu as the need arises.
51. Student will be charged for minimum 20 days diet for a month, otherwise payment will be made for the whole month.
52. At the start of session and the end of session, if no. of working days in a month as per academic calendar is upto 5 days then 1/5 of the monthly charges will be charged and if no. of days is upto 10 days then 1/3 of monthly charges and if upto 15 days then 1/2 of monthly charges will be charged from the students by the mess contractor. Therefore, the contractor shall not charge any other extra amount from the students. The contractor shall not have a right to close the mess during holidays or vacation, pandemic period without prior permission of competent authority as the mess facility may be required during these days.
53. The Caterer/bidder shall not make or permit any construction or structural alteration of additional fitting inside the premises of the work place without prior written approval of the authorities.
54. Issues, specifically clarified in the contract shall be settled with mutual consent between the contractor and Mess committee/competent authority, without vitiating the basic premises of the contract. Further, any dispute is subject to the jurisdiction of Ambala (Haryana) only.
55. The aforementioned terms & conditions shall be binding and operative between the tenderer

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(contractor) and the Institute.

56. The contractor will vacate the mess and canteen and handover the possession of the premises on the expiry of the term of the contract or on termination of the contract. If the contractor fails to vacate the mess premises on stipulated date then damage charges for the over stay at the rate of Rs. 1000/- (One thousand) per day will be recovered from the contractor out of the performance security deposit. If the performance security deposit is insufficient to recover damage charges then the same will be recovered from the contractor or through the court of law.
57. Canteen timings: Summer: 8:00 am to 7:00 pm & Winters: 8:00 am to 6:00 pm.

Penalties for violation of rules, terms and conditions

If rules, terms & conditions are not followed properly and strictly, the contract can be cancelled by the Principal without any explanation and notice time.
